Builders Without Borders is launching an appeal for donations to mobilize construction specialists to work on reconstruction projects in Haiti.

Donations by Canadians to be matched by Canadian Government!

How will Canada's Haiti Earthquake Relief Fund work?

The Government of Canada will match dollar for dollar the contributions of individual Canadians to registered charities in support of humanitarian, recovery, and reconstruction efforts in response to the earthquake in Haiti, up to a total of \$50 million. The government will then use the relief fund to provide assistance through Canadian and international humanitarian and development organizations, as per established channels and procedures.

To count toward the Haiti Earthquake Relief Fund, donations must be:

- made by an individual Canadian;
- made to a registered charity that is receiving donations in response to the January 12 Haiti earthquake;
- specifically earmarked by such organizations for the purpose of responding to the earthquake; and,
- made between January 12 and February 12, 2010.

The Canadian International Development Agency will allocate the funds to established Canadian and international humanitarian and development organizations through the CIDA-managed Haiti Earthquake Relief Fund.
